Eligibility Criteria:

For Ph.D. Programme:

- 1. Candidates having Master's degree with 55% marks {(50 % for SC/ST/ OBC& PWD (PH)} or its equivalent grade from any UGC recognized University in India or an equivalent degree of a recognized foreign University are eligible to apply for admission to the Ph. D Programme of study in his /her disciplinary subject of study or in a subject of allied discipline or in an inter disciplinary subject. Provided further that a relaxation 5% marks from 55% to 50% may be given for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991.
- 2. Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M.Phil. Degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an appropriate authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible to seek admission to Ph.D. Programme.

Exemption to Written Test/ Research Eligibility Test (KNU-RET):

Candidates having cleared NET/SLET/SET/GATE/JEST/DST-INSPIRE/DBT-JRF/M.Phil. at the time of notified closing date of application form are exempted from appearing Written Test/Research Eligibility Test.

Admission Procedure (Ph. D.)

All candidates (other than ones as mentioned above) will have to appear for a Written Entrance Test, and if qualified, have to appear for an interview/viva-voce to be conducted by the respective Department Research Committee.

Research Eligibility Test (RET) and Interview:

Written Entrance Test or Research Eligibility Test and Interview will be taken for selection of eligible candidates for admission to Ph.D. Programmes.

RET will be of 100 marks. Total duration of the Test will be of 3 (three hours). RET will have two parts each of 50 marks.

Part-I will be on Research Methodology.

Part-II will be subject specific.

Qualifying Marks:

In order to qualify for the Interview, each candidate will be required to score at least 50% considering Part-I & Part-II of written test.

Interview:

Each and every qualified candidate in Written Entrance Test and the candidates who have qualified/cleared M.Phil as per UGC Regulations, 2009 /NET/SLET/SET/GATE/JEST/DSTINSPIRE/DBT-JRF will be required to appear in Interview/ Viva Voce to present and defend their research proposal. The Interview will be conducted by the respective Board of Research Studies of the Departments.

Reservation of Seats

Reservation of seats will be as per the reservation rules of the Government of West Bengal.

Publication of Merit Lists

Provisional lists of the candidates selected for (a) Written Entrance Test and (b) NET / SET etc. qualified candidates exempted from Written Entrance Test, will be published separately on the Colleg website. The date of publication of the lists and mode of examination will be notified in due course. Please follow College website on regular basis for updates.

How to collect Admit Cards

Admit Cards will have to be downloaded by the candidates themselves by entering their Application Identification Number printed on their downloaded Application Form. The admit Card will be required to be produced at the time of Entrance Test. Candidate will not be allowed to sit for the Entrance Test without Admit Card.
