Profile of the College



Location:

Triveni Devi Bhalotia College is a Govt- sponsored College, situated in the heart of Raniganj town, in the district of Burdwan, West Bengal. The college campus is equidistant from Punjabi more (NH2) and Raniganj Railway Station. The nearest bus stop is 'School More' which is at a 5mins walk from the college.

About the College:

The journey of this college began from 1957 as an affiliated college under the University of Calcutta. However it became affiliated to the University of Burdwan in 1960. The college presently came under the aegis of Kazi Nazrul University on 24th June 2015. This institution is co-educational and has the morning and day sections.

Campus:

The College has a beautiful green campus covering approximately 15 acres of land. The campus not only includes the academic buildings but also has sprawling playgrounds, a small courtyard with a badminton court, residential hostels for both boys and girls and Staff quarters. It also houses a branch of a Nationalized Bank. Besides, the campus provides an open air stage- the "Binoy Chaudhury Mancha" in the vicinity of the Central library in the south- eastern fringe. This auditorium is used during the annual social as well as for various cultural activities organized by the students and staff.

Library:

The College takes pride in having a separate smart central library building to meet the growing demands of its students. The college library has a collection of approximately 85,000 books, ancient manuscripts, periodicals, magazines and journals for reading, referencing or borrowing. Students are issued two borrower cards (reading room card and lending card) each at the time of admission. Apart from the general library each department has a seminar library, which the students can access at the discretion of the departmental faculty. The central library has been fully automated and installation of INFLIBNET allows the students to have easy access in browsing and for reference work. The library also provides a quiet and peaceful reading room that is conducive for learning and referencing.

Boy's Hostel:

The boy's hostel is located at the north-eastern corner of the campus. The hostel accommodates 100 students. It is a well planned two storied building with separate dining room facility. The hostel has its own mess run by the boarders on hygienic standards. Ragging is strictly prohibited. A separate study room, indoor games room and internet facilities are present. Accommodation in the hostel is provided under the rules and regulations formulated by the college authority.

Girl's Hostel:

A separate girls hostel exclusively for UG and PG students is present at the southern end of the campus. The hostel provides safe and comfortable accommodation for 18 students.

Students' Health Care Facilities:

A health care clinic is maintained by the college authority in the campus. A general physician attends the clinic and is on call whenever required.

Open Air Stage:

The campus provides an open air stage- the "Binoy Choudhury Mancha". It is the venue for various cultural activities organized by the students and staff.

Playground:

The College has a football ground, badminton and a volleyball court, where students practice and compete in different games and sports of intra- and- inter College competitions. The play-scape also provides a safe and green environment.

Common Room:

The College is proud to possess a separate girls' and boys' common room which provides indoor games facilities. The activities of the common room are controlled and monitored jointly by the teachers and the Students Union.

Nationalized Bank :

A branch of the Syndicate Bank is serving the teachers, staff and students of the college campus. The branch has CBS facility.

Career Counseling Cell:

Triveni Devi Bhalotia College helps its students to step up steadily in their future career and life as well. A Career Counseling Cell is very much proactive to explore diverse fields of employment for graduates and post graduates. To kindle the interest of the students towards achieving their goal in life, the Career Counseling Cell conducts support programmes and workshops that enhance their chances of future placement and their skills respectively. The Cell has been successful in bringing companies, like TCS, Pinnacle Infotech, ABP Bangla, Shyam Steel etc., to name a few, to the campus head hunting so far and these relentless efforts to provide the best of the opportunities to its students for their future continues.

College Canteen:

This is a single storied structure near the main gate where the students and staff of the college can have hygienic food at a reasonable price. It is run by a Voluntary Organization and functions during the working hours of the College.

The college has two units of NSS for boys and girls separately.

Scholarship/Awards/Concession and Aids

Financial aids of the following categories are provided to the economically backward and meritorious students each year.

1. Govt. Scholarship: stipend for SC/ST students and national scholarships for the meritorious students are sanctioned by the government.

2. Students Aid Fund: This fund helps the poor meritorious students to submit their University Examination fees.

3. Free Studentship : Full & half free concession is granted to economically backward and meritorious students as per government rules.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC)

In accordance with the Action Plan the National Assessment and Accreditation council (NAAC), Bangalore for performance, evaluation, assessment and accreditation and quality up-gradation of institutions of higher education, T.D.B. College has set up its Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). It is a part of institution's system and works towards realization of the objectives of quality enhancement and sustenance. IQAC plays the role of a coordinator in ensuring the maintenance of quality in all spheres of activity in the college and integrates academics administration and related arenas.

The IQAC, headed by the Principal of the college includes teachers, non-teaching staff, members from local society and industry. The IQAC has played a pivotal role towards the NAAC accreditation of the college. During the post-accreditation period, the IQAC will channelize the efforts and measures of an institution towards academic excellence through conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the overall performance of institution.

Guidelines relating to Admission to B.A / B.Sc. / B. Com (Honours and Programme) courses of Studies for the academic session 2017-2018

The objective of the following guidelines is to make the admission merit based, hassle free and transparent

1. These Guidelines shall be called the Kazi Nazrul University Admission guidelines relating to Three year B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com (Honours and Programme) Degree Courses of Studies.
2. These shall apply to every candidate pursuing the above Courses in this University
3. These Guidelines shall be effective from the Academic Session 2017-2018

Admission Criteria (For B.A. / B.Sc. / B. Com (Honours and Programme) Courses

4. Candidates passing the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination with 5 (Five) recognized subjects including atleast one language subject having full marks not less than 100 is eligible to seek admission to the B.A. / B.Sc. / B. Com (honours and Programme) Course of Studies
5. Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent examination (10+2 level) from any approved Council or Board or University (as per attached list) in the year 2014/2015/2016 and 2017 are eligible for the admission in the under graduate courses. Admission into the under graduate courses will be made on the basis of merit and in accordance with the approved intake capacity of each college, Annexure – I
6. Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Vocational Education and Training shall be eligible to seek admission to the Programme Course of Studies.
7. A Candidate taking up Programme Course must have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) or its equivalent Examination.
8. A candidate taking up Honours Course in a subject must have obtained.

A minimum of 45% marks in the aggregate at the qualifying examination provided all other clauses are satisfied.

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission in Honours Course, it is to be noted that total marks obtained by a candidate in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination has to be calculated by summing up the marks of 4 subjects excluding Environmental Studies in which the candidate has secured highest secured highest among which exactly one must be a language subject. If the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

9. Seat reservation in the degree courses of studies shall be guided by the :

West Bengal State Higher Educational Institution (Reservation in Admissiin), Act 2013

West Bengal State Higher Educational Institution (Reservation in Admission) Rules, 2014

West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions policy of reservation to Persons with Disabilities.

10. A state or national level sports person may be considered for admission to Honours Courses under sports quota if found otherwise eligible.

Further, a district or state or national level sports person with pass marks in H.S. Examination may be considered for admission in Programme courses under sports quota.

Admission to Sports Quota will be guided by the relevant Government Order in this regard.

11. Candidates who have qualified 10+2 or equivalent examinations from foreign Universities or boards are also eligible for admission to any affiliated colleges. They can apply for the 5% of the total seats allotted for the under graduate courses of the concerned college.
12. The students who are admitted in the under graduate courses may apply for the change in the subject within 3 weeks from the commencement of the classes.
13. Inter College transfer is not permissible except in special cases with the approval of the University Authorities
14. No Registered Undergraduate student of this University shall pursue any other full time regular course of study leading to a degree simultaneously in this University or any other University
15. For the B.A. / B.Sc. / B. Com (Honours and Programme) course or studies Kazi Nazrul University offers the following subjects.

1. **Some Special conditions for admission to Honours Courses as follows :**

2. **(i) Economics :** A Candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in Economics if he / she has passed in Mathematics at the H.S. Examination (10+2) Students who have passed Business Economics including Business Mathematics in H.S. (10+2) level are also eligible for admission in the Honours Course in Economics.
3. **(ii) Mathematics :** A Candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in Mathematics if he / she has passed in Mathematics at the previous qualifying Examination . A candidate who has passed Business Mathematics is not eligible for admission to the Mathematics Honours Course .
(iii) Chemistry : A Candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in Chemistry if he / she has passed in Physics, Chemistry & Mathematics at the previous qualifying Examination .
(iv) Bio-chemistry : A candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in bio – Chemistry if he / she has passed in Physics, chemistry, Mathematics and Biology / Bio-Technology at the previous qualifying examination.
(v) Physiology : A candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in Physiology if he / she passed the subject Physiology / Biology / Bio-Technology and Chemistry in the previous qualifying examination. The subject Biology / bio-Technology may be treated as the related subject.
(vi) Nutrition : A candidate shall be allowed to take up Honours in Nutrition if he / she has passed in Chemistry at the previous qualifying examination.
Computer Science : A Candidate shall be allowed to take up honours in Computer Science if he / she has passed in Mathematics or Physics or Statistics or Electronics at the previous qualifying examination.
17. For awarding B.Sc. Degree subjects under Psychology Geography and Mathematics shall be treated as the subjects of Science division
18. Course Structure with Distribution of Marks for B.A. / B.Sc. / B.Com (honours and Programme) Course Studies are given in the university Website : www.knu.ac.in

Admission Schedule

1. All admissions have to be made through online, and on the basis of merit. Any deviation from the merit system will be treated as a strong departure from Kazi Nazrul University of Admission.
2. This year the online admission process via college portal to the Under Graduate Courses of Studies shall start the next day after publication of the result of H.S. (10+2) Examination, 2017, conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education and the online admission college portal be remained open 7 days after publication ISC / CBSE (10+2) result for registration for admission.
3. Candidates who passed 10+2 Examination or its equivalent Examination in 2014 and onwards are eligible to seek admission to the above mentioned Courses of Studies.
4. Entire admission procedure will have to be completed within 60 days from the date of publication of result of Higher Secondary Examination 2017 of the West Bengal Council for Higher Secondary Education ISC / CBSE.
5. Intake capacity of Each college (stream wise / subject wide including reservation). As stipulated by the University, will have to be followed strictly. The reservation of seats has to be made as per the West Bengal Government orders and rules. The university will be. In no way responsible for the non registration of the students admitted beyond the intake capacity.
6. All the procedural and administrative modalities prescribed in G.O. Numbers 908-Edn (CS)/10M-95/14 dated 17.11.2014 492-Edn (CS) 10m -95/14 dated 02.06.2015 and 500-Edn (CS) /10 m -95 /16 dated 08.05.2017

The students shall be admitted subject to fulfillment of conditions as laid down in this University Admission guidelines dated 23.05.2017 and the relevant provisions of West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions Reservation in Admission Act 2013, the West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission Rules 2014 and West Bengal State Higher Educational Institutions policy of reservation to Persons with disabilities should be strictly followed.
