Concept Note:

Elie Wiesel's quote, 'Sometimes we must interfere. When human lives are endangered, when human dignity is in jeopardy, national borders and sensitivities become irrelevant,' encapsulates his philosophy of moral responsibility and active intervention in the face of injustice. The conference titled "Borderlines: Redefining Political Landscapes in a Divided World" aims to explore the multifaceted dynamics of borders in the contemporary geopolitical context. Borders, both physical and conceptual, have evolved from simple territorial demarcations to complex political tools that influence migration, security, trade, identity, and environmental policies. This event seeks to redefine the understanding of borders as spaces of division and connection while addressing the challenges and opportunities they present in a rapidly changing global landscape. Borders have increasingly become sites of contention, reflecting global inequalities, security concerns, and identity politics. The rigid enforcement of borders often exacerbates humanitarian crises, disrupts cultural exchanges, and limits economic opportunities. Conversely, borders also serve as bridges for cooperation, trade, and shared governance. The conference will address the paradoxical role of borders as both barriers and facilitators in shaping political landscapes.

Requirements for Submission:

- Length: Full papers should be between 3,000 and 5,000 words.
- **Presentation time:** Up to 20 minutes. The papers can be presented both in physical and virtual modes.
- Format: Manuscripts should be submitted in .docx or .pdf format, using Chicago citation style.
- Abstract: Submissions must include an abstract (300-500 words) outlining the aims, methods, and conclusions of the paper.
 We encourage contributions from scholars working in History, Sociology, Gender Studies, English, Political Science, Anthropology, Bengali, and related disciplines. Selected papers will be published in a peer-reviewed volume after the conference.

Please keep in mind the following additional points when submitting papers:

- 1. Papers must be written **in English or Bengali**, word-processed, and double-spaced. The paper should be sent only in WORD (.doc/.docx) file format. Please refrain from submitting hard copies or uploading the soft copy of the paper in PDF format.
- 2. Word limit: Full papers should be between **3,000** and **5,000** words (**including endnotes**). Any paper exceeding the word limit will not be eligible for inclusion in the Proceedings. The paper submitted should be in **Times New Roman font (for English), Kalpurush font (for Bengali), font size 12, double-spaced.**
- 3. References should be double-spaced and placed at the end of the paper, numbered continuously throughout the entire document (not per page).

- 4. When referencing printed books, the conventional system should be followed: Author's name, Title of the book, Place of publication, and Year of publication, in that sequence. For well-known journal abbreviations such as JIH, JASB, JRAS, EI, IHR, IESHR, and JESHO, utilise them without further clarification. Forms like 'ibid', 'Op. cit.', etc are recommended for conciseness.
- 5. If maps, diagrams, and photographs are provided, they should be limited in number and prepared in a format ready/suitable for printing.
- 6. The paper will be submitted via email at <u>bvck.webinar@gmail.com</u> (Kindly submit the abstract as of now; the full paper will be sought later.)
- 7. A hard copy of the paper must be submitted by the Paper Presenter at the time of the presentation to the Chairperson of the relevant session.
